Championship/Competitions & Leagues Regulations U14, U16 & Minor

1. Where teams finish with equal points for qualification for the concluding stages, the tie shall be decided by the following means and in the order specified:
 - a. Where two teams only are involved - the outcome of the meeting of the two teams in the previous game in the competition.
 - b. Scoring Difference (subtracting the total Scores Against from total Scores for);
 - c. Highest Total Score for;
 - d. A Play-Off. **Note:** *In U14 and U16 & Minor championships (b) & (c) above will only apply to the games concerning the teams who have finished level on points (where three or more teams finish level).*

2. Championship/competition and league games shall be played in accordance with fixtures. A postponement may only be granted by the Competitions Control Committee following a written application from the Cathaoirleach or Runaí of the Club requesting the postponement and for the following grounds:
 - a. Death of Father, Mother, Brother, Sister, Child, or Grandparent of a player.
 - b. Death of a Club President, Officer (Eight Elected Officers as defined in 7.2 of the TO)
 - c. Club Constitution 7.2) or Clergyman.
 - d. Exceptional circumstances, at the discretion of the Competitions Control Committee. Games postponed for reasons in (2) above will be re-fixed for a date not later than 4 days of the original fixture, provided appropriate notice is provided.

3. **Requests to bring a fixture forward or a time change, must have the agreement of both clubs and will only be accepted for consideration by email, 72 Hours before the fixture is scheduled to be played. Exception: request for postponement in accordance with Co. Board Regulation No. 20.**

4. Except in urgent cases (venue unplayable, referee unavailable, postponement in accordance with Bye-Law No. 20), fixtures and disciplinary queries shall be by email only, from the club/team Secretary or Chairperson.

5. The Competitions Control Committee (CCC) may play championship/competition and league games under floodlights. If a club has no floodlights, they must nominate a pitch for home games, if required. Failing to do so the Competitions Control Committee (CCC) will nominate a pitch.

6. **Underage teams whom concede a match will lose home advantage in their next fixture.**

Additional Regulations for Championship/Competitions

- Championships Hurling & Football 15 a side.
- Competitions Hurling & Football- 13 a side. (Larger Panels League Guideline #1 applies)
- Competition QF & SF are home/away venues.
- Competition Finals are neutral venues.
- Championship QF are home/away venues.
- Championship SF & Finals are neutral venues.
- Clubs/independent teams entering 2 teams into championship/competitions. 15 names to be forwarded prior to first game. These 15 players can only play in first team. Additional players (In their last year of that grade) who play one match on the first team cannot play on 2nd team. Players in their first year of this grade can play up and down.
- (U14, U16 & Minor) - In accordance with Rule 3.7 T.O. Part 2 - If a knock-out game in an underage championship/competition (Play-Offs, Quarter Finals & Semi Finals), up to and including Minor (U-18), ends in a draw, two periods of extra-time of ten minutes each shall be played. If after extra time it is still a draw, "Winner on the day regulations" will then apply. All finals ending in a draw, two periods of extra-time of ten minutes each shall be played. A replay will take place if extra times end in a draw. If the replay ends in a draw two periods of extra-time of ten minutes each shall be played. If after extra time it is still a draw, "Winner on the day regulations" will then apply.

Minor Additional Regulations for Leagues (Only)

1. Minor Hurling/Football league matches may be played with a minimum of 13 players and unlimited substitutions shall be allowed throughout the game. Please note:
 - a. If both clubs have 15 players toggled out they must play a 14-a-side.
 - b. If both clubs have 16 or more players toggled, they must play 15-a-side.
 - c. If additional players arrive after the start of the game players may be increased by agreement up to a maximum of 15
2. Extra time and WOTD to be played in all Play-Offs, if necessary.

Please note the following in relation to referee fees for the knockout stages of Championships/Competitions 2025:

1. Championship & Competition finals will take place at a neutral venue. All Underage finals are are ticket only matches. Offaly GAA will reimburse the host club for referee expenses- (€50 for final).
2. Championship/Competition quarter finals are home/away. Home club to cover referee expenses- €40.
3. Championship semi-finals will take place at neutral venues. Both Club to split the referee expenses. - €40
4. Competition semi-finals are home/away. Both Club to split the referee expenses. - €40

- Hurling/Football Feile matches may be played with a minimum of 13 players and unlimited

substitutions shall be allowed throughout the game.

Please note: If both clubs have 15 players toggged, they must play 14-a-side.

If both clubs have 16 or more players toggged, they must play 15-a-side.

If additional players arrive after the start of the game the numbers may be increased by agreement up to a maximum of 15-a-side.

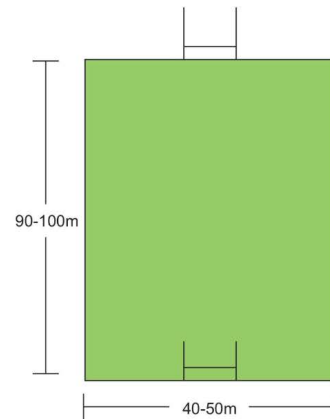

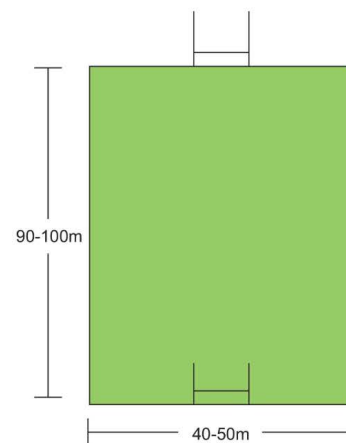

- At puck outs, the player gets a second chance if he misses first time

U8 & U10 & U11 Go Games – Regulations

Teams/Players/Substitutions

- Clubs to submit a Foireann Team sheet prior to the start of Go Games.
- All players should play a minimum of one half/2 games
- All clubs should be encouraged to promote an equal playing time ethos where younger players are not playing above their age grade unless necessary due to a lack of numbers within a catchment area.
- There are no limits on the number of substitutions which may take place during a game.
- Each team shall introduce a minimum of two substitutes at designated stages of the game, as follows: On the referee's T signal, substitutes shall be introduced 10 minutes into the first half and 5 minutes into the second half. These players shall remain on the field for the remainder of the game (except in the case of injury). When these substitution breaks are taking place, all players and coaches to remain in position. (This is not an opportunity for team talks).
- Please view National Go Games Regulations for pitch dimensions & additional guidelines.

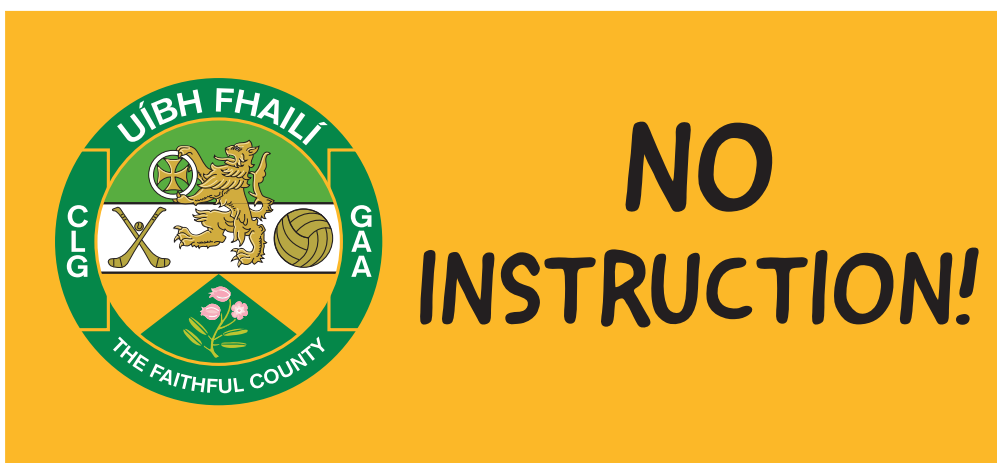
U8, U10, U11, U12 & U13 Silent Sidelines

- The designated coach who provides instructions throughout the games must wear a bib to identify himself/herself. (At U8/U10 level, If the designated coach is the Referee, the sideline must remain quiet).
- All parents and supporters to be informed of Silent Sideline Procedures by club secretaries. Clubs must erect the Silent Sidelines Sign during games.
U11, U12/U13- Referees to report all incidents involving players, mentors, supporters and
→ parents/guardians. Clubs are responsible for their players, mentors, supporters and all known partisans' behaviour towards their own players, opposing players, coaches, the referee and opposing Club members.
- Go Games U8, U10 – Go Games Coordinators to report all incidents involving players, mentors, supporters and parents/guardians. Clubs are responsible for their players, mentors, supporters and all known partisans' behaviour towards their own players, opposing players, coaches, the referee and opposing Club members.
- Foireann team sheets must be submitted to secretarybng.offaly@gaa.ie within 24 hours of the blitz or game. It is imperative that we receive these submissions promptly to ensure efficient processing and organization of the events.
- Please be advised that teams will not be permitted to participate in the next round until the team sheets for the previous event are received and processed.

Disciplinary procedures for all reported infractions by mentors, officials, supporters and parents will be referred to the CCC, irrespective of the age group in which the reported infractions took place. Club Officials may have to identify individuals reported in Referee/Go Games Coordinator's Reports.

Winner on the Day Regulations

Regulations approved by Ard Chomhairle on 03.12.2022 and in accordance with Rules of Specification 3.4. & 3.5 T.O. Part 2 2022, that relevant games that are “Winner on the Day” should be completed as follows:

Phase 1

- Proceed to Extra time as provided for in T.O Cuid II (two periods of ten minutes each way)

Phase 2 (Penalty Kicks/Pucks)

If still level, a “penalty competition” to decide the outcome:

- The relevant rules in T.O. Cuid II shall apply in relation to Penalty Kicks/Pucks, unless otherwise stated.
- Penalties will be taken for goals only.
- The Referee shall choose the end at which the penalty kicks/pucks will be taken. The end may be changed by the referee if it becomes unplayable during the course of the penalties.
- The Referee will ensure two goal umpires are in place at the end in which the penalty kicks/pucks are to be taken;
 - Both umpires shall position themselves on the end line at opposite side of the goals facing inwards
 - If a penalty is scored, the goal umpire, will wave the green flag once the referee has signaled
 - If the penalty is saved or missed the point umpire will signal a wide once the referee has signaled
- Only players who are on the field of play at the end of Phase 1 (i.e., end of Extra Time), shall be allowed to be registered as a penalty taker or goalkeeper. **Exception:** The substitute goalkeeper can come from the team panel.
- Each team shall register five penalty takers, a goalkeeper & a substitute goalkeeper with the referee and indicate in which order the penalty takers will take their penalties. (A penalty taker can also be a goalkeeper or a substitute goalkeeper, provided they were on the field at the end of the phase 1.)
- The Referee shall toss a coin in the presence of the two captains to see which team will have the option of going first.
- Subject to the conditions below both teams will take five penalty kicks/pucks which are taken alternately by the teams. The game is awarded to whichever team scores more of their five penalty kicks/pucks
 - If, before both teams have taken five penalty kicks/pucks, one team has scored more goals than the other team could score, even if they were to complete their five penalty kicks/pucks, no more penalty kicks/pucks shall be taken
 - If, after both teams have taken five penalty kicks/pucks and both teams have scored the same number of goals, the penalty competition will continue but in sudden death format using the same five registered players until one team has scored a goal more

than the other from the same number of kicks/pucks.

- In sudden death, the same sequence of penalty takers does not have to be followed as in the first round of penalty kicks/pucks.
- Each penalty kick/puck is taken by a different player. All registered players must take a penalty kick/puck before any player can take an additional penalty kick/puck.
- The referee shall signal for the penalty to be taken. The penalty kick/puck is completed when the ball stops moving, goes out of play (including over the crossbar) or a goal is scored.
- Only the players involved in the penalty taking competition, as well as the Referee, Linesmen and Umpires are permitted on the pitch. With the registered penalty takers located between the 45m & 65m lines closest to the end selected by the referee. Goalkeepers to be located 20m from the goals.
- All other players (including substitute goalkeepers), managers, officials, backroom personnel etc. should be at their designated sideline area, and off the field of play when the penalty-taking competition is taking place.
- A goalkeeper who is injured (or sent off) while the penalty kicks/pucks are being taken and are unable to continue as a goalkeeper may be replaced* by the substitute goalkeeper who has been nominated in advance, provided the referee is notified. If in the event the substitute goalkeeper also gets injured, one of the registered penalty takers may replace* the substitute goalkeeper, provided the referee is notified. (*Once replaced, the goalkeeper/ substitute goalkeeper cannot be reintroduced as a goalkeeper at a later stage).
- In the event the goalkeeper who is injured while the penalty kicks/pucks are being taken and is unable to continue and is also a registered penalty taker, they may be replaced by a player who was on the field of play at the end of Phase 1 (i.e., end of Extra Time), provided the change is approved by the referee. If the goalkeeper has taken a penalty, the replacement cannot take a penalty until the next round of penalties.
- In the event a registered penalty taker is sent off by the referee while the penalty kicks/pucks are being taken, they may be replaced by a player who was on the field of play at the end of Phase 1 (i.e., end of Extra Time), provided the change is approved by the referee. If the sent-off player has taken a penalty, the replacement cannot take a penalty until the next round of penalties.
